Creative Ballet	Creative Ballet	Introduces children ages 3 and 4 to basic motor movement, rhythm, and listening skills.
Pre-Ballet	Pre-Ballet	Pre-Ballet serves as an introduction to the classroom And body movement for students ages 4,5-5 and 6.
Beg	Beginners	Suitable for complete beginners.
Beg/Elem	Beginners / Elementary	Beginners and those with already some experience.
Elem	Elementary	Thoroughly knowledge and stable bases of dance or class(es) of choice.
Gen	General	Should possess a basic knowledge of selected class style(s) and unreservedly to enhance skill level.
Int	Intermediate	Level is designed to strengthen technical skills and increase technical proficiency leading to the intermediate / advanced and advanced levels. Point shoes for girls and women are included in ballet classes.
Int/Adv	Intermediate / Advanced	Improved level of dance with a particular style.
Adv/Pro	Advanced / Professional	Degree or certification level through course study or self-education. Also for pre-professional dancers of advanced standing who wish to prepare for a career in performances.

Levels from Beginners / elementary to professional are encouraged to take secondary classes with their main technique classes which develops well-rounded dancers.
